

Refreshing the Oiled Floor

From time to time, the floor should be refreshed, for example when the surface shows signs of wear such as a grey or dull appearance. In living areas, refreshing is usually needed 2–4 times per year, depending on how often the room is used. In heavily used rooms, refreshing may be needed more often. Each time the floor is refreshed with oil, it becomes more beautiful and more durable.

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Care Instructions

according to DIN 18356 and DIN 18367

Oiled and impregnated floors keep the natural surface of the wood, but they need more care than sealed floors. Please follow the instructions below so that you can enjoy your wooden floor for many years.

General Information

Oiling or impregnating protects the wood and makes it largely resistant to water penetration. The ability of the wood to “breathe” is not affected by oiling, impregnating, or waxing. Regular care is necessary, as required by DIN 18356 for parquet floors and DIN 18367 for wood block flooring. If the surface of an oiled floor becomes damaged through use, it can be repaired afterwards by applying oil again, even only on the affected spot.

Indoor Climate

For personal comfort and for maintaining the quality and value of the wooden floor, the ideal indoor climate is: Temperature: 18–20 °C and relative humidity: 50–60%

When the air humidity is high, the wooden floor absorbs moisture and expands. When the air is dry—such as during the heating season in winter—the wood releases moisture and shrinks. Small gaps may appear.

This is normal and shows that the floor is made of natural wood. During the heating season, you should add humidity to the air

if possible. A warranty for the surface treatment is only valid if these care instructions are followed and if a care system recommended or approved by us is used.

After Installation

A freshly oiled or impregnated wooden floor may only be walked on the next day. Full use is possible after 8–14 days. During the first two weeks: Clean only dry (no wet cleaning), do not place carpets or rugs on the floor and place furniture and other items carefully. Table and chair legs should have felt pads (for example, plastic-covered felt). If chairs with wheels are used, only use soft wheels according to DIN 68131.

Regular Cleaning and Care

Coarse dirt and sand act like sandpaper and should be removed with a broom or vacuum cleaner. Fine dirt or dust can be cleaned with a slightly damp mop.

We recommend adding MAGIC CARE OIL REFRESHER or WOODEN WOOD FLOOR SOAP to the water (see dosage in the product instructions).

Deep Cleaning

Manual or machine deep cleaning is only necessary if visible layers of dirt or residue have built up. For this purpose, use a neutral cleaner or deep cleaner.
